- 4.God has immeasurable greatness and power toward us who believe. He is in charge. What would shift in your view of yourself if you believed this? What would shift in your view of the world if you believed this?
- 5. Pray that our church would know and experience, in a deep way, the hope we have in Christ, the treasure we are to God, and the power God has to save us.
