MONTHLY MEMORY VERSE:

ONE BIG THING: Jesus helps us honor God with our emotions.

REVIEW: This week in CitiKids we read “A dark night in the garden” from the Jesus Storybook Bible. We learned that emotions are the inside and outside reactions we have to things that happen to us. Sometimes when we have strong emotions, we sin in response to them. But Jesus never did that! Jesus was fully God and fully man. So he felt all sorts of things - happy and sad and angry and tired. But he NEVER sinned. He ALWAYS did the right thing. When we believe in Jesus and trust Him, His Spirit is with us always. He is our Helper. When we feel sad, angry, jealous or afraid, we can pray to God like Jesus and He will help us to obey Him!

PRAY TOGETHER AS A FAMILY:
