Read Galatians 5:16-25 and Luke 10:25-37 and recap the sermon.

1. What stood out to you from the sermon or passage? What convicted you? What comforted you?
2. How do you see selfishness in your own life? What are ways you are tempted to turn inward and focus on yourself rather than turn upward towards God and outward towards others? How do you need to repent of that this week?
3. In the sermon we said that love: (1) necessitates action, (2) crosses to the other, (3) is willing to be interrupted with compassion, and (4) sacrifices at great cost to itself.
 - a. In which of these areas do you see a weakness in your love for those around you?
 - b. In which of these do you see a strength in your love for those around you?
4. In the sermon, we said that "Jesus is the Good Samaritan, and we are the beat up man on the road. He sacrifices Himself in love for us."
 - a. How is this Gospel good news for you?
 - b. How does Christ's love for you compel you to sacrifice in love for others?
5. Take a second to look at the practice guide together.
 - a. What is your plan to practice these two things - Abide and Sacrifice - this week?
