Hallow – To make, treat, or set apart as holy.

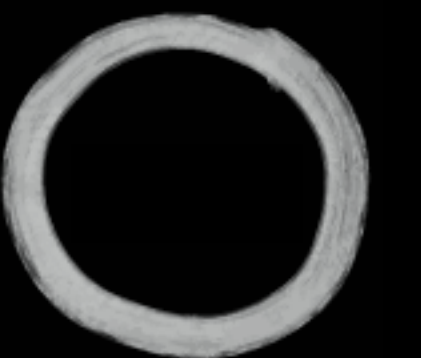

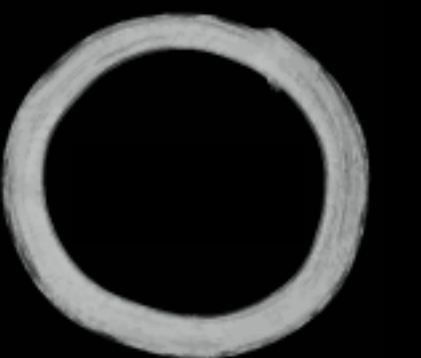
**Pray that God Himself

and more about ours.**

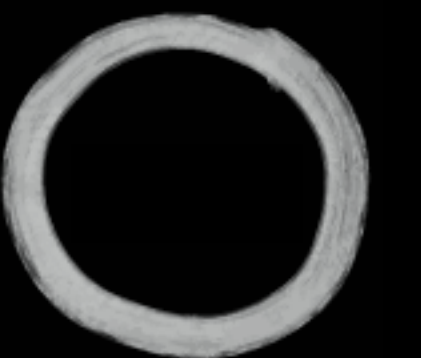

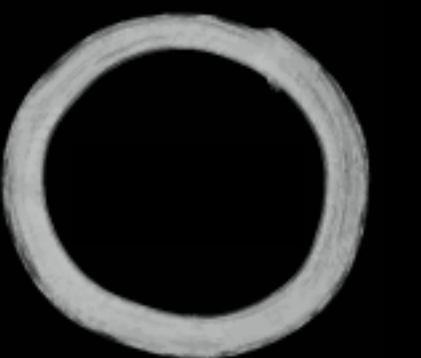

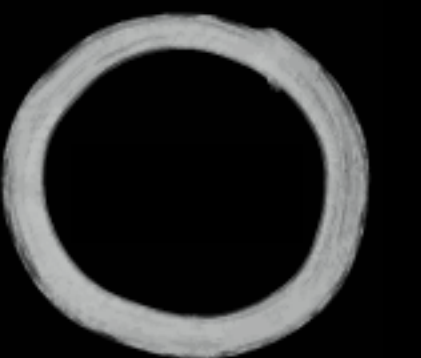
Adoration:

A means of hallowing God's Name by declaring true things about God to God.

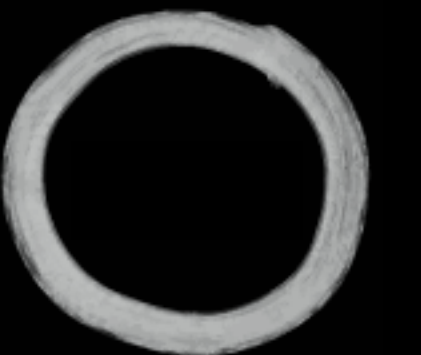
